All effort is made to ensure affordable costs. For individual service,

- Main Course Meals \$4.50
- Salads \$4.50
- Snack Pack \$3.50
- Sandwich \$2.00
- Soup Pack \$3.50
- Desserts \$1.20

Juice is free and provided with your meal. Group catering costs are available on request.

How do I pay?

For individual clients, each Monday our volunteers will bring a receipt book and change, to enable you to pay your account. Otherwise, you can make arrangements with service staff to pay on an alternate day, fortnightly, through your carer or have your meal payment deducted directly through Centrelink.

Home delivered

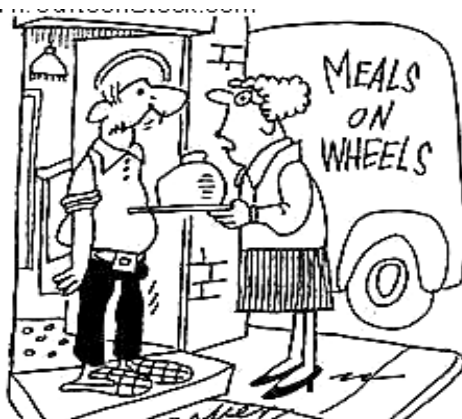
A chilled or frozen nutritious meal can be delivered to your door every working day. A hot meal can be provided to people who cannot re-heat their meals.

How does it work?

We provide a flexible range of high quality food to meet the individual needs of clients and groups. Deliveries are made by our dedicated volunteers from Monday to Friday between 9:30am to 12:00 noon.

We aim to provide both varied nutritious meals. Every effort is made to cater for particular diet needs.

For individual clients, after an initial referral is received, service can commence within two working days. An assessment will be conducted within 12 weeks of starting with the service to ensure the service is meeting needs.

However, changes to meals ordered can be made by calling the office a day in advance. Annual assessments will be conducted to monitor ongoing needs.

We can also help with your other meal needs by providing simple meal ideas or a referral to a nutritionist (at no charge).

Group orders can be made by contacting the office who will provide menu and costing options.
